

Notice of KLTRO206, Stow Bardolph and Wimbotsham

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (KLTRO206) affecting **A) C5 Stow Bridge Road** from its junction with A10 Stow Bardolph Bypass to its junction with C51 Wimbotsham Road ("Road A"), **B) C51 Wimbotsham Road/West Way** from its junction with C5 Stow Bridge Road for 1,085 metres southwards ("Road B") and **C) C5 Stow Bridge Road** from its junction with U21530 Lynn Road for 30 metres eastwards ("Road C") in the Parishes of Stow Bardolph and Wimbotsham to facilitate mains laying scheme works, the Roads A-C will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 7th September to 29th November 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 29th May 2027 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

NB: It is anticipated that these works will take place in phases:

Road A – Phase 1 is anticipated to take place from 7th September to 26th October 2026. Phase 2 is anticipated to take place from 28th September to 26th October 2026.

Road B – Phase 3 is anticipated to take place from 26th October to 29th November 2026.

Road C – Phase 4 is anticipated to take place from 23rd to 29th November 2026.

Alternative route is via: A10 Stow Bardolph Bypass, Lynn Road, Broomhill, Low Road, West Way, Wimbotsham Road, Stow Bridge Road (Downham Market, Wimbotsham, Stow Bardolph).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Anglian Water.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 29th May 2027 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

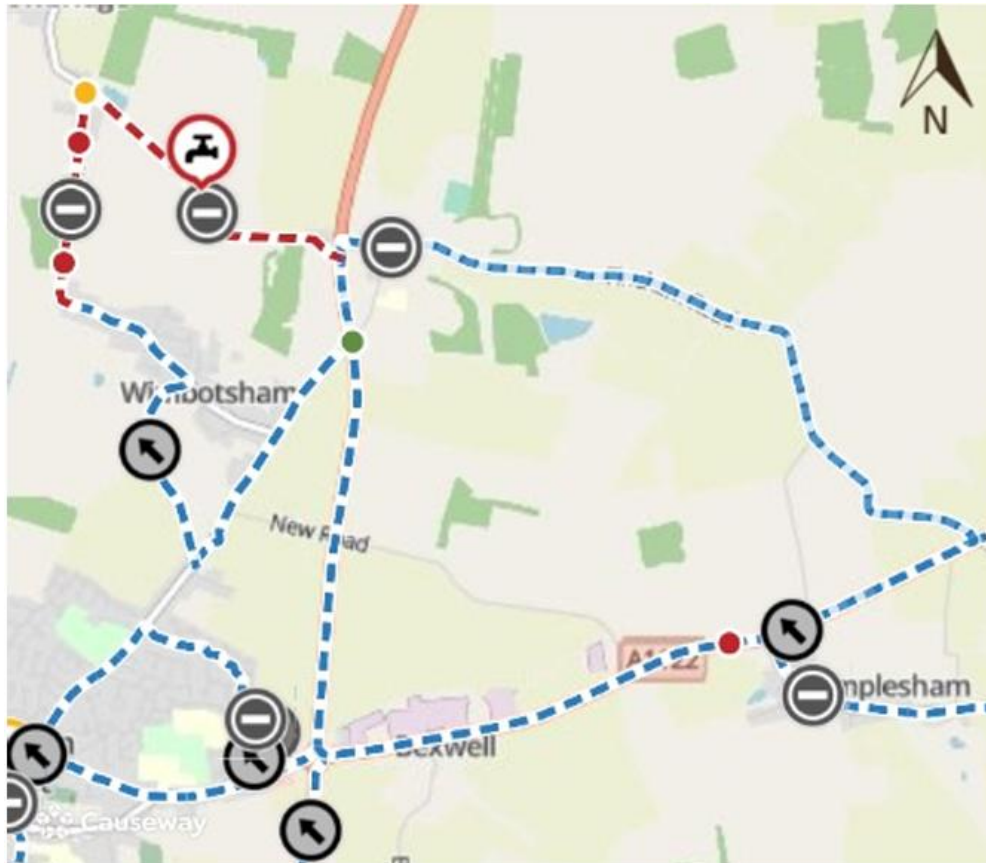
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

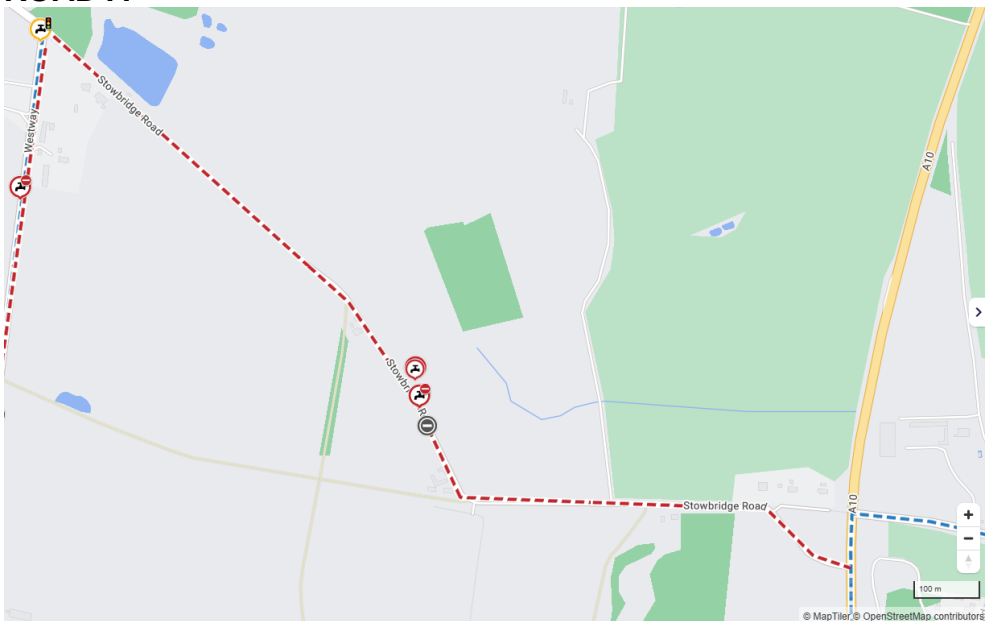

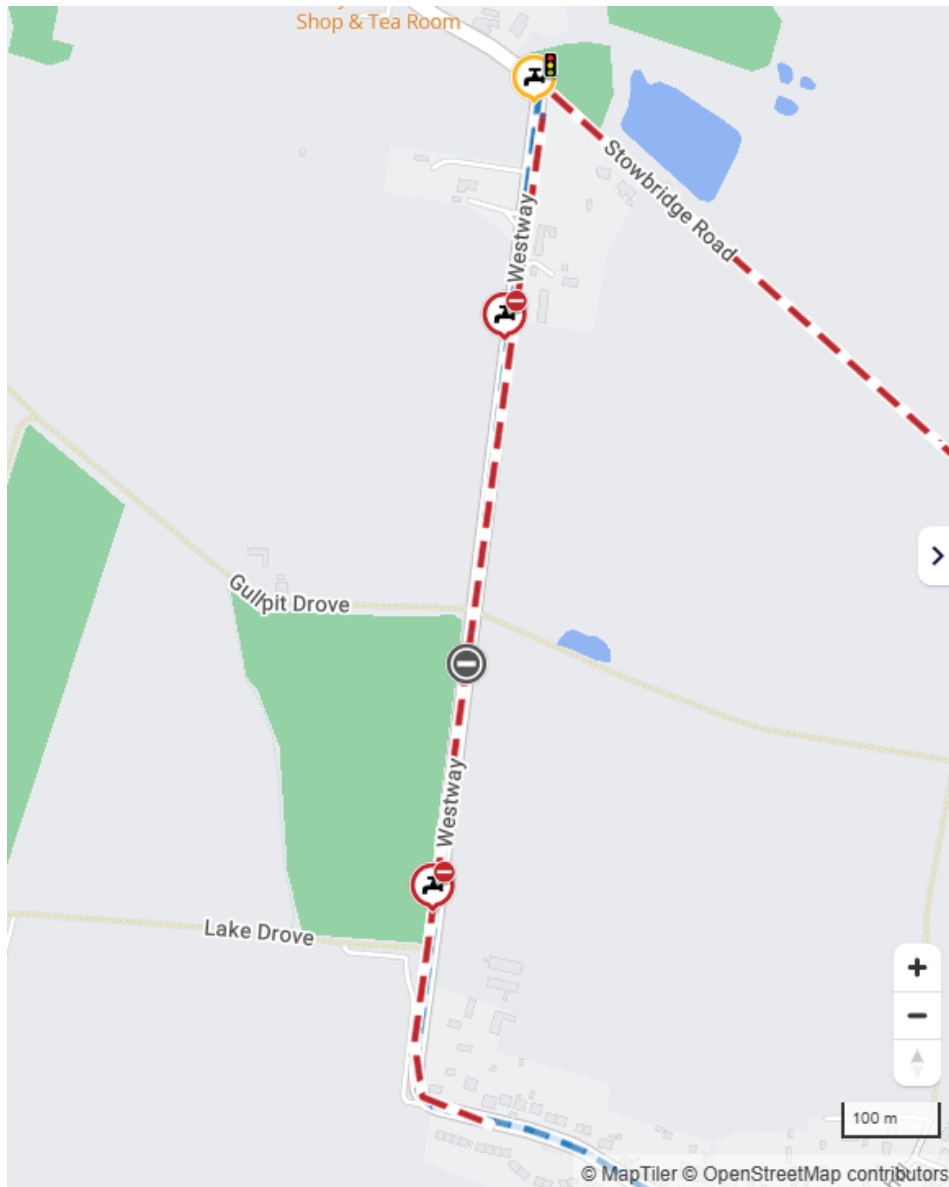
