

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (WTRO6361) affecting the A1122 Southern Bypass from 20 metres southeast of the railway level crossing to 20 metres northwest of the railway level crossing (the "Road") in the Parish of Downham Market to facilitate railway track alignment works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 22:00 on 29th June to 05:00 on 30th June 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 11th August 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Southern Bypass A1122/Western Bypass, Station Road, Bridge Road, Downham Road, Outwell Road, Wisbech Road, Basin Road, Elm High Road, Wisbech Bypass, A47, West Winch Road, Main Road, Lynn Road, A10 Stow Bardolph Bypass/ Downham/Wimbotsham Bypass/ Downham Eastern Bypass (Watlington, Downham West, Tilney All Saints, Stow Bardolph, Nordelph, Denver, Terrington St. John, Walsoken, Walpole Highway, North Runcton, Elm, Emneth, Wimbotsham, West Walton, Ryston, West Winch, Tilney St. Lawrence, Wormegay, Outwell, Tottenhill, Runcton Holme, Downham Market).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: National Railways – Centurion.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 11th August 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

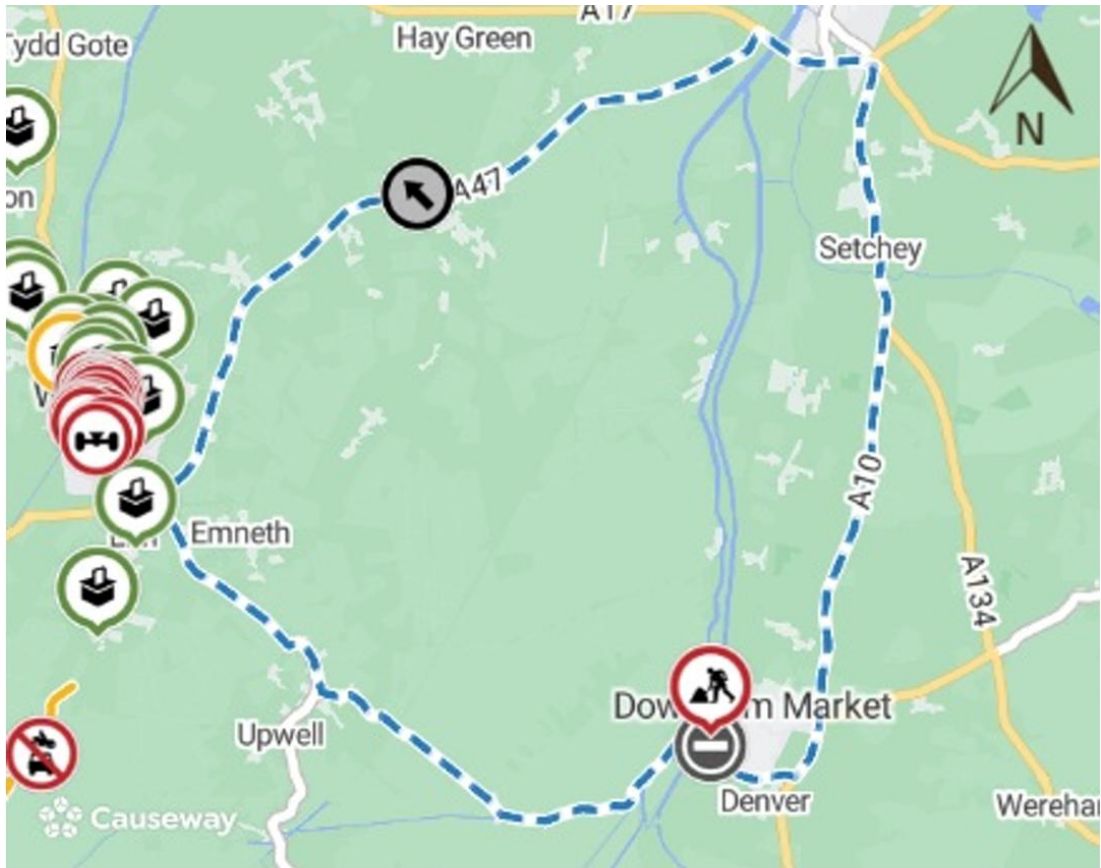
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

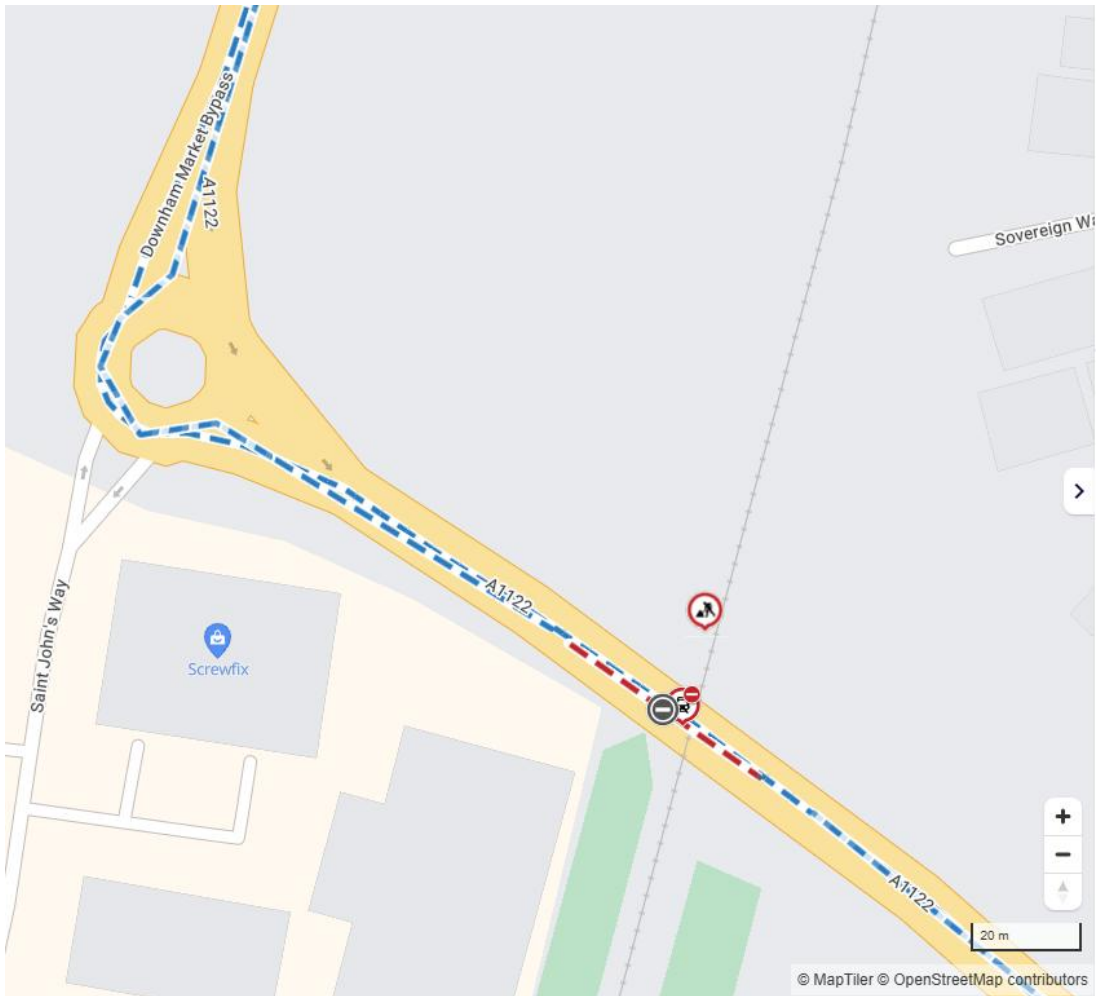
