Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (WTRO6092) affecting the Stow Road from 750m south of its junction with Burnt Lane for 545m southwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Wiggenhall St. Mary Magdalen to facilitate HRA patching works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 27<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> October 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Stow Road, Church Road, Station Road, Britton Close, School Road, Downham Road, Watlington Road, Holme Road, The Causeway, West Head Road, Low Road (Watlington, Stow Bardolph, Wiggenhall St. Mary Magdalen, Runcton Holme).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
