Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting of the Stow Bardolph Parish Council Held at Barroway Drove Village Hall on Tuesday 10th January 2023

1. To receive apologies for absence

1.1 Apologies were accepted from Parish Councillors Mr W Esse, Mrs S Clanfield & Mr G Bishop.

2. To receive any declarations of Interest in items on the agenda

2.1 Cllr Dent declared a non-pecuniary interest in agenda item 10c (request for donation towards shed by St Peter's Church)

3. To approve and sign the minutes of the meeting held 8th November 2022

3.1 The minutes of the meeting were approved without amendment and signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

4. Clerk's report (for information only)

- 4.1 The Clerk reported that the new Grit Bins will be installed in the summer, as the old ones had already been refilled with grit.
- 4.2 The notice board in Stow Bridge cannot be easily repaired and will therefore be replaced; this has been budgeted for and the Clerk will liaise with the Chairman to agree the details of the replacement.
- 4.3 All other matters that the Clerk has been working on are covered by the agenda.

5. To receive updates from Borough and County Councillors

- 5.1 Cllr Spikings confirmed that photographic ID will be required for anyone wishing to vote in person at the elections in May.
- 5.2 Cllr Rose provided information on cost-of-living help and support (to be passed on to residents by notice boards, website and social media).
- 5.2 Cllr Dawson reported that the County Council are in the process of setting next year's budget, which bis likely to see a 5% increase. Cllr Dawson also reported that he has taken on the role of Champion for Rural Businesses and will provide more information on this in due course.

6. Open Forum for public participation

6.1 No members of the public were present.

7. To discuss any Highway Matters

- 7.1 A report on all previously identified issues had been circulated to Members ahead of the meeting (and is attached at appendix i).
- 7.2 Several new potholes have, very recently, appeared around the parish, and existing ones grown in size, therefore the Clerk will review the whole parish over the next week and report to Highways accordingly.

7.3 Work to complete the extension to the footpath in Barroway Drove is due to start on 16th January; the estimated costs of this work have increased from £50,000 to £62,000 – this is due to increased cost of materials since the original quote and funding bid were submitted. Cllr Dawson suggested applying to the Parish Partnership Fund for the shortfall and the Council Members agreed the Clerk should action this as soon as possible.

8. To discuss any Street Light Matters

- 8.1 No faults were reported.
- 8.2 Due to changes with the energy supplier, no bill for the last financial period has been received, making it difficult to predict costs for the forthcoming year. The Clerk will contact the supplier regarding this matter.

9. To discuss Planning Matters

- 9.1 The Council noted the results of previous applications and the responses from the Planning Advisory Group to applications received for consultation since the last meeting (see report attached to January 2023 agenda).
- 9.2 There were no new planning applications for review.
- 9.3 A consultation regarding changes to the planning system is open until 2nd March; the Clerk will send details to all council members via email.

10. To discuss and agree Finance Matters

- 10.3 The Council **RESOLVED** not to grant money to St Peter's Church for a replacement shed; this decision was based on guidance from the National Association of Local Councils.
